This week in Friedberg's History: On November 27, 1759, Ludolph Gottlieb Bachhof preached in Adam Spach's home held "below the Ens", with several German families present; almost four years after he first requested for the Moravians to come. The heads of the attending families were Adam Spach, George Hartman, Johannes Muller, Michael Faber, Christian Frey, Peter Frey, Martin Walk, Christian Hartman and Christian Zimmerman. The exact location of this house is not known. This meeting was before the building of Adam's famous Rock House. Preaching continued at various times and the number of attendees increased. Br. Bachhof would later become the first full time minister at Friedberg.
