The Boy Scouts of America annually celebrates its founding on February 8, 1910, based on the program started by Lord Baden Powell in England on August 1, 1907. The Scout Sunday tradition was started to make people in houses of worship aware of Scouting, and to allow Scouts to live out their "Duty to God" pledged each week. The Scout Law says that a "Scout is Reverent" and the Scouts of all ages promise to do their "Duty to God". These values strengthen youth character in their family, community and faith. The Boy Scouts of America maintains that no member can grow into the best kind of citizen without recognizing an obligation to God. In the first part of the Scout oath or Promise when the member declares "On my honor I will do my best to do my duty to God and my country and to obey the Scout Law." The scout is recognizing that God is the ruling and leading power in the universe. The scout gives grateful acknowledgment of God's favors and blessings, things that are necessary to be the best type of citizen and are the wholesome precepts in the education of the scout. This is the day that we recognize and thank Friedberg Moravian Church for all the support and history we have had together.
