# March 24, 2024 Palm Sunday

**Watchword for the Week –** Jesus said, "You will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of Power and coming with the clouds of heaven." Mark 14:62

On this day long ago, our Lord Jesus Christ entered the city of Jerusalem to joyous shouts of "Hosanna" (a phrase which means "save"). Let us tell the world about our Savior, so that more and more people can experience the joy of salvation and join us in serving Him!




