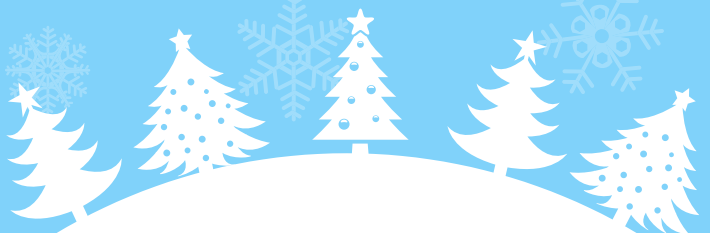

Program. This will include costumes and everything. Please make sure to have your child at this practice so they will know what to do the next day for the actual program!

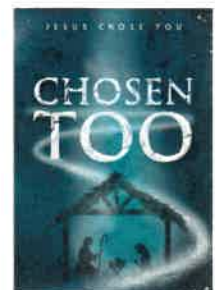

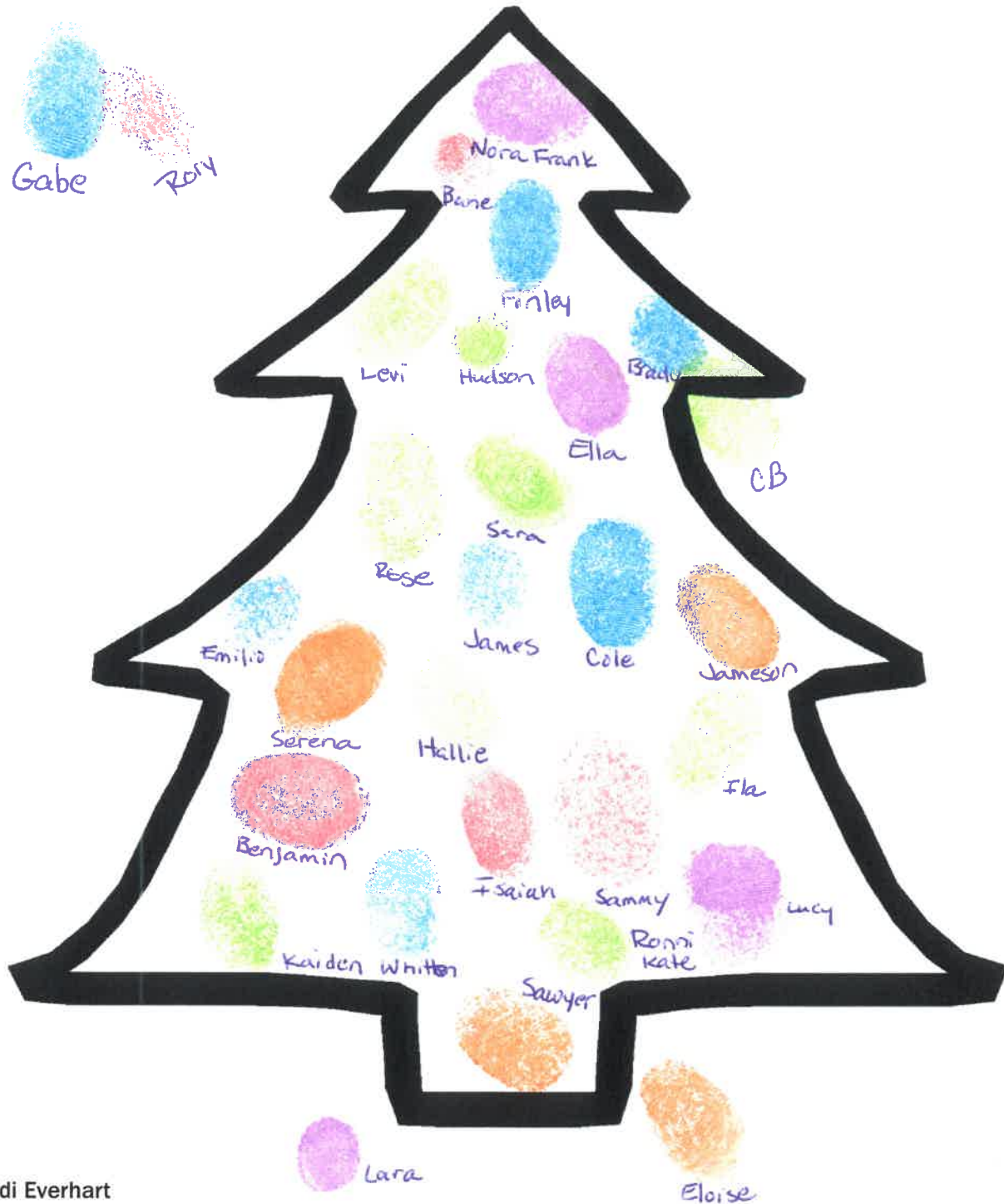

Visit Mallard Ridge

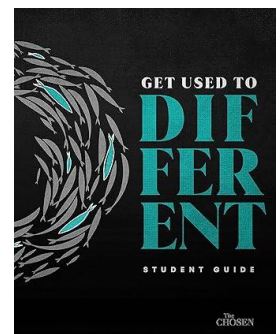

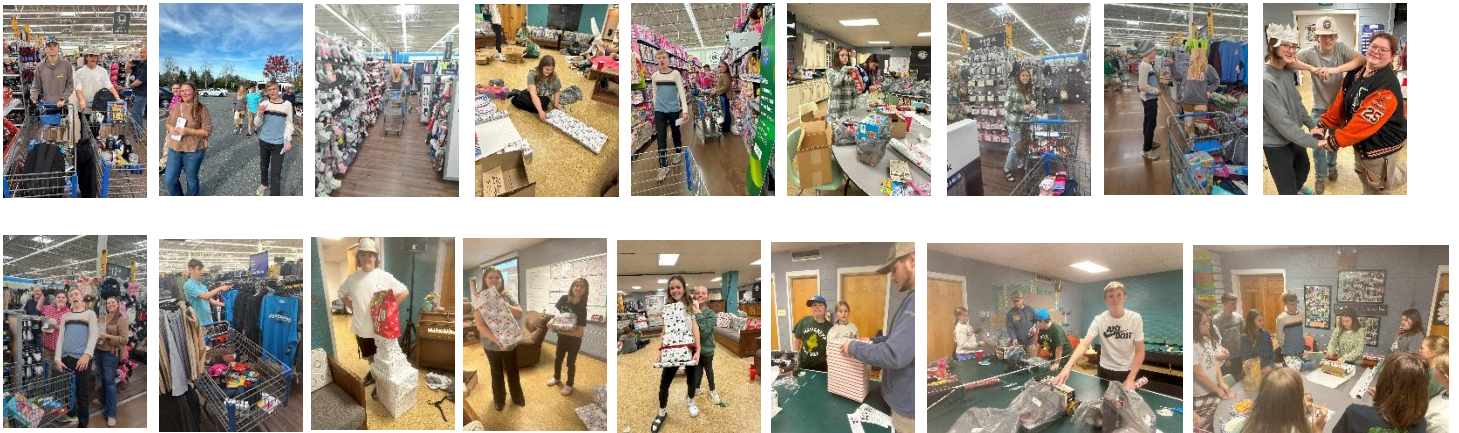
