Watchword for the Week – Let those who fear the Lord say, "His steadfast love endures forever." Psalm 118:4

As we worship Him with joy on this holy day, let us also recommit ourselves to serving Him with gladness! Let us tell the world about our Savior, so that more and more people can experience the joy of salvation and join us in serving Him!






