## A Prayer for America

On Sunday, January 25 — a very wintery day, with just 15 people attending worship in-person in our sanctuary, but nearly 400 more worshipping online via our livestream, I preached a message titled *“Lord, Teach Us to Pray for Our Nation.”* This sermon was born out of a desire to call us to pray fervently for America in this year when we celebrate her 250th birthday.

The message was built around five prayer needs for America:

### 1. A Call to Repentance and Humility

*If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, pray, seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, forgive their sin, and heal their land.* (2 Chronicles 7:14)

### 2. Healing of Our Deep Moral and Relational Fractures

*But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ. For He Himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility.* (Ephesians 2:13-14, NIV)

### 3. Truthfulness in a Culture Addicted to Outrage

*Jesus said, “If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”* (John 8:31b-32, NIV)

*My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.* (James 1:19, NIV)

### 4. Renewal of the Church’s Witness

*You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.* (Matthew 5:14-16, NIV)



### 5. Hope Rooted in God Alone

*Do not put your trust in princes, in human beings, who cannot save.* (Psalm 146:3, NIV)

*Those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.* (Isaiah 40:31, NIV)

I ended with a prayer that sought to address the points covered in the sermon.

The message seems to have resonated with people because as of this writing the service has received 475 online views — the most of any service here at Friedberg since our Christmas Eve Lovefeast and Candle Service in 2023. If you’ve not yet viewed the service I invite you to visit our YouTube channel and do so.

In the last few days I have had several requests for copies of the prayer that followed the sermon — enough to where I thought it would be helpful to copy it here:

*Gracious and sovereign God, Lord of heaven and earth, Maker of all peoples and all nations — we come to You not with demands, but with humility. Not with certainty, but with trust. Not asking You to bless our agendas but asking You to bless us by reshaping our hearts.*

*We confess, O God, that it is easier to speak about what is wrong with our nation than to name what is broken within us. We confess pride that disguises itself as conviction, certainty that leaves no room for listening, and zeal that forgets love.*

*Forgive us, Lord, for the ways we have drifted from You while still speaking Your name. Forgive us for trusting our own righteousness more than Your mercy. Humble us — not to shame us, but to heal us. Begin Your work here, among Your people. Begin it in us.*

Lord Jesus Christ, You are our peace. You did not come to create a shallow peace that avoids truth, nor a unity built on silence or denial. You came to tear down every wall that keeps repentant sinners from Your grace — and You came to draw a clear line of allegiance that calls every heart to faith and obedience.

On the cross, You broke down the walls that said some were too far away, too different, too unworthy to belong. And yet, You also told us plainly that following You would bring division — not because You delight in conflict, but because truth exposes false loyalties and light unsettles the darkness.

Forgive us, Lord, for rebuilding walls You died to destroy — walls of fear, pride, and hostility. Forgive us for confusing obedience with unkindness, conviction with contempt, and faithfulness with fear. Teach us to live in the unity You create — unity rooted in repentance, sustained by grace, and held together by submission to You alone. Kill in us what You put to death on the cross, and give us the courage to follow You even when faithfulness costs us peace with the world.

Holy Spirit, source of truth and wisdom, deliver us from the noise of outrage. We are surrounded by voices — loud voices, confident voices, angry voices — and we confess how easily we confuse volume with truth.

Forgive us for sharing what confirms us instead of what forms us. Forgive us for speaking quickly and listening slowly. Teach us again the wisdom that comes from above: pure, peaceable, gentle, open to reason. Guard our words. Shape our thoughts. Make us people whose speech brings light rather than heat, clarity rather than chaos, freedom rather than bondage.

God of the Church, renew our witness in this land. Forgive us when we have tried to be relevant instead of faithful. Forgive us when we have been silent about our own sin while shouting about the sins of others.

Strip us of arrogance. Clothe us with humility. Give us courage without cruelty and conviction without pride. Let Your Church shine — not with borrowed power, but with holy love; not with anger, but with hope; not for our glory, but for Yours.

And finally, O God, we place our hope where it truly belongs. We confess how easily we trust what is visible, what is immediate, what feels strong — even though it cannot last.

In this stormy season, when winds howl and ice weighs heavy, remind us that there is a kingdom that cannot be shaken. Free us from fear of outcomes we cannot control. Loosen our grip on false saviors. Anchor us again in Your reign. Renew our strength as we wait on You. Teach us to rest in Your sovereignty. Teach us to trust Your timing. Teach us to hope — not in circumstances, but in You.

Hear our prayer, O Lord — for we offer it not in our own confidence, but in the name of Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

Brothers and Sisters, whether you pray this particular prayer for America or not — please pray! Pray that our hearts, our church, and our nation might be shaped more by faithfulness to Christ than by fear of the times in which we live.

# Moravian Day of Giving 2026

## FM Youth Participation Challenge

On Tuesday, February 17, 2026, Moravians across North America will come together once again for a day dedicated to generosity and shared mission. Friedberg Moravian Youth would like to challenge the Friedberg Congregation to participate in this shared mission. Moravian Ministries Foundation in America (MMFA) has set up a participation challenge in which six churches or organizations with the highest number of individual donors will receive \$2,026. If the FM youth receive the funding, it will support mission trips this summer.

MMFA will award \$2,026 to the six Moravian organizations (churches, agencies, camps, etc.) that have the most unique individual donors during the Moravian Day of Giving

Here's how it works:

- **Each Individual Must Donate to Their Organization of Choice**
  - If you want your church or favorite Moravian organization to receive credit, you must donate directly to that organization through MMFA's Giving Portal. [www.mmfa.com/giving-portal](http://www.mmfa.com/giving-portal)
  - Your church does not get credit if you donate to a different Moravian organization.
  - If you donate to more than one organization in a single transaction, all organizations will receive credit for your participation.
- **Household Donations**
  - When donating, select the "individual" option to ensure each donation is tied to one name at a time.
  - Donations made as a household will count as one unique donor.
  - To count as two unique donors, each family member or spouse must make separate donations.



## **Following God's GPS-A Family Devotion on Psalm 25:5**

**Scripture:** "Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior." - Psalm 25:5a (NIV)

Have you ever been lost? Maybe you couldn't find your classroom on the first day of school, or you got separated from Mom or Dad at the store. It's a scary feeling, isn't it?

The good news is that we never have to feel lost when it comes to following God! In today's verse, David is asking God to be like a guide—someone who knows the way and can show us where to go.

**Think about it:** When your family goes on a trip, you might use a GPS or a map to find your way. God's truth is like the best GPS ever invented! It never loses signal, it never takes us the wrong way, and it always leads us exactly where we need to go.

### **A Question to Ponder**

**For kids:** What's something you need God's help with right now? Maybe a friendship problem, a hard decision, or something you're worried about?

**For parents:** Where do you need God's guidance today? Your children are watching how you trust God with your own questions and challenges.

### **Try This Together**

Tonight before bed, hold hands as a family and take turns finishing this prayer:

*"God, please guide me in...[your situation]."* *"God, please teach me about...[what you want to learn]."*

Remember: God loves you and wants to guide you. He's not hiding His truth from you—He wants you to know it! All you have to do is ask, just like David did.

### **A Simple Prayer**

*Dear God, thank You that You are our Savior and our Guide. We don't always know which way to go, but You do. Help us to listen for Your voice, to read Your Word, and to follow where You lead. We trust You to teach us what we need to know. Amen.*


**Family Challenge:** This month, when you face a choice or problem, say out loud: "God, guide me in Your truth!" Then take a moment to pray and listen. You might be surprised at how God answers!


#### Sweetheart Banquet Sunday, February 15<sup>th</sup> (12:00 – 2:00 pm) Fellowship Hall


