If you are graduating from high school or college, please complete the following by May 10:

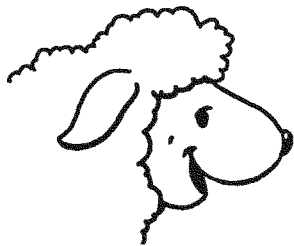

We would love for you to join us for breakfast beginning at 9:30 in the Family Life Center on June 7th, 2026.

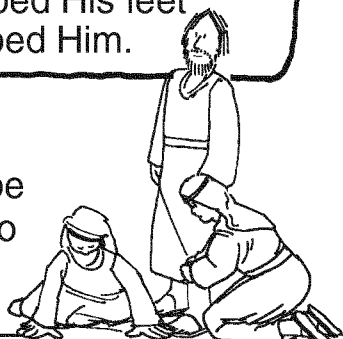
